HOW TO ACHIEVE YOUR MONTHLY REMITTANCE

2023, september 1st

What to provide us with? (on the Excel file provided by PGQ or an Excel extraction)

1. **UPPER PART OF THE REPORT** : your contact details, particularly your name and address. Information related to the date, period covered, preparation, tax numbers). On the PGQ Excel file, calculations of subtotals, taxes, fees and taxes on fees are done automatically to indicate the amount of the transfer or check to be made.
2. **PRODUCER'S NAME AND ADDRESS** : according to the information contained in your producer lists.
3. **RECEIPT VOUCHER** : if available, your reference number relating to the transaction.
4. **RECEPTION DATE (dd-mm-yy)** : grain delivery or payment date, in the format dd-mm-yy. **Please note**: this date is very important because it determines which list of contribution rates will be used.
5. **GRAIN (name or code)** : each cell has a drop-down list which allows you to choose the name of the grain or its code, which determine the contribution rate, in accordance with the list available on the following page.
6. **QUANTITY (M.T.)** : delivered quantity in metric tonnes.
7. **CONTRIBUTION RATE** : automatically displayed based on reception date (before or after 01-09-23 which is the date when rates were changed) and grain name or code chosen.
8. **AMOUNT OWED** : automatic calculation of the delivered quantity multiplied by the contribution rate.

How to submit your report

Electronically (planconjoint@pgq.ca)

- Excel file according to the model available on the PGQ website at www.pgq.ca, under the quick section *Acheteurs-Contributions au Plan conjoint* at the bottom of the home page.
- Excel file from your own extractions from your information system. Ensure that each line allows easy identification of the producer and the reported transaction, according to the same instructions as in the Excel file provided by the PGQ.

Paper form

- Paper form available on request.
- Your own forms or reports, as long as the required information is clearly available.

How to transmit your payment

- Through bank transfer.
- By check, dated no later than the 15th of the month following your purchases reported (indicate « Plan conjoint »).
