Appendix B

Agreement between Producteurs de grains du Québec
and the Producers taking part in the Advance Payments Program

I (we) hereby:

Authorise that:

1. All lending institutions reveal to Producteurs de grains du Québec all necessary information concerning my (our) credit records subject to my (our) advance payment request (s) for the 2026-2027 crop year;
2. Producteurs de grains du Québec or its representative be permitted at all times to visit the premises where the grains are stored in order to control the quantities for which Producteurs de grains du Québec detain a privilege according to the Program;
3. the insurance company, which has insured the crop, must pay the indemnity to Producteurs de grains du Québec in case of a sinister. Also, La Financière agricole du Québec is permitted to give information, (from my personal file) to Producteurs de grains du Québec as to the amount insured and the yield protection, or any other information needed by Producteurs de grains du Québec to process my file;
4. the buyer withholds and pays to Producteurs de grains du Québec the total amount of a sale that is part of the crop covered by the program, within fourteen (14) calendar days of any grain delivery. Upon receipt of the total amount forwarded by the buyer and of the blue copy of the delivery slip mailed by the producer on the day of the sale, Producteurs de grains du Québec will return to the producer the exceeding amount of the unitary rate prescribed by the Act, once the joint plan contributions have been deducted, if need be;
5. Producteurs de grains du Québec consult the compilation of contributions to the Joint Plan received from buyers and attesting the delivery of grain harvested by the producer;
6. Producteurs de grains du Québec can disclose the balance of the advance to the producer's financial institution upon request from the latter.

In case of a sinister (fire, theft, water or any other contamination) on the harvest that becomes unfit for sale or consumption, the producer will have to reimburse the advance plus interest at prime rate plus 1 % on the unpaid balance from the date the advance was issued until the date of default and, prime rate plus 3 % starting at the default date until complete reimbursement of the debt.

The producer remains liable to the producer organization for repayment of any part of the advance where the authorized buyer or broker has not remitted to the producer organization that part of the advance withheld by him in accordance with the Act. In the event that Producteurs de grains du Québec have to incur legal charges in the collection of any amount due, I (we) undertake to repay all charges without exception, including legal and extrajudicial fees.
